



## FLYING ETERNITY SCARF

designed by Margery Winter



EASY

### KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

13" wide x 27" long/33cm x 68.5 cm  
(when folded in half)

### MATERIALS

- 3 balls Filatura di Crosa **FLYING** [37% alpaca, 37% wool, 25% acrylic, 1% polyamide; 1.75oz/50g; 82yd/75 m] in color **#03 cocoa (A)**
- 2 balls in color **#02 latte (B)**
- One pair size US 11 (8mm) needles
- OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE**
- Yarn needle (to weave in ends)

### GAUGE

7 sts and 10 rows = 4"/10cm in St st using 2 strands of yarn held tog

### TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

**NOTE:** Scarf is knit with 2 strands of yarn held together throughout.

### ABBREVIATIONS

beg	begin(ning)
k	knit
p	purl
p2tog	purl 2 stitches together
RS	right side
st(s)	stitch(es)
tog	together
WS	wrong side

### SCARF

With 2 strands A held tog, beg at the Slanted edge, cast on 1 st.

**Row 1 (RS)** Knit.

**Row 2** P into front & back of st – 2 sts.

**Row 3** K into front & back of first st, k to end – 3 sts.

**Row 4** P to last st, p into front & back of last st – 4 sts.

Repeat the last 2 rows until there are 23 rows and 23 sts.

**Next row (WS)** K1, purl to last st, k1.

**Next row (RS)** P1, knit to last st, p1.

Repeat these 2 rows until piece measures 20"/51cm when measured along the short end. Cut A and join 2 strands B. Work even in St st for 20"/51cm more with B.

**Slant the 2<sup>nd</sup> side**

**Next row (RS)** K to the last 2 sts, k2.

**Next row (WS)** P2tog, purl to end.

Repeat these 2 rows until 1 st remains. Fasten off. Sew the first slanted edge in A to the slanted edge in B to complete the cowl. Weave in ends.
