



MONTANA FRINGED NECKWARMER

designed by Rosemary Drysdale



EASY

SIZE One size

KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

9"/23 cm wide x 36"/91.5 cm long

MATERIALS

- 1 hank Tahki Yarns **MONTANA** 100% pure new wool (3.5oz/100g; 132yds/120m) in **color #1 natural**
- One pair size 15 (10mm) needles
- OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE**
- One pair size 13 (9mm) needles
- Yarn needle

GAUGES

10 sts and 17 rows = 4"/10 cm in

Seed st using larger needles

12 sts and 20 rows = 4"/10 cm in

Garter st using smaller needles

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGES

PATTERN STITCHES

Garter stitch (knit every row)

Seed Stitch (odd number sts)

Row 1 *K1, p1; repeat from * across, end with k1.

Row 2 Knit the purl sts & purl the knit sts as they face you.

Repeat Row 2 for Seed st.

SPECIAL TERMS

K1-f/b (Knit 1 front and back increase)

Knit next stitch, then knit it again through the back loop.

K2tog Knit 2 stitches together.

NECKWARMER

With larger needles, cast on 23 sts.

Work in Seed st until piece measures 6" from beginning, end with a WS row.

Decrease Row (RS) K1, *k2tog; rep from * across – 12 sts.

Change to smaller needles and work in garter st until piece measures 30" from beginning, end with a WS row.

Increase Row (RS) K1, *k1-f&b; repeat from * across – 23 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Change to larger needles and beginning with Row 1, work in Seed st until piece measures 36" from beginning. Bind off.

FINISHING

Block pieces to measurements. Cut 10 lengths of yarn, each 10". Fold lengths in half and knot randomly around wide ends of Neckwarmer. Weave in ends.
