



## RITRATTO RUFFLED DRAPE-FRONT JACKET

designed by Jan Hurwitz



**SIZES** Small (**Medium**, Large, **X-Large**)

### KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

**Bust** 36 (40, 44, 48)"/91.5 (101.5, 112, 122) cm

**Length** 19 (20¼, 21½, 22¼)"/48.5 (51.5, 54.5, 56.5) cm

### MATERIALS

• 7 (8, 9, 9) balls S. Charles Collezione **RITRATTO** 53% viscose, 28% kid mohair, 10% nylon, 9% polyester (1.75oz/50g; 198yds/180m) in **color #96 teal multi (shown)** OR COLOR OF YOUR CHOICE

- One pair size 5 (3.75mm) needles **OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE**
- One size 5 (3.75mm) circular needle, 32"/80cm long, for Neck
- Stitch holders
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle

### GAUGE

22 sts and 28 rows = 4"/10 cm in Stockinette stitch

**TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE**

### PATTERN STITCHES

**Stockinette stitch** (St st)

Knit on RS, purl on WS.

**Garter stitch** – Knit every row.

***NOTE:** Pieces are worked from cuff to center. BACKS are sewn together at center back. FRONTS and BACK are sewn together at top and bottom of SLEEVES, and along sides.*

### LEFT BACK

**Half Sleeve**

Cast on 106 (110, 116, 120) sts. Knit 1 row.

### Shape Ruffle

**Dec Row (RS)** \*K2tog; rep from \* to end – 53 (55, 58, 60) sts rem. Change to Garter st (knit every row); work even for 5 rows.

### Shape Sleeve

**Inc Row (RS)** Change to St st, dec 1 st each side this row, then every 4th row 4 times – 43 (45, 48, 50) sts rem. Work even until piece measures 14½ (15, 15½)" from beginning, end with a WS row.

### Shape Underarm

**Inc Row (RS)** Inc 1 st at beginning of this row, then every 4th row 4 times – 48 (50, 53, 55) sts. Work even for 1 row.

## Body

**(RS)** Cast on 56 (**60**, 64, **68**) sts, work to end – 104 (**110**, 117, **123**) sts. Work even until piece measures 9 (**10**, 11, **12**)" from last cast-on edge, end with a WS row. Place sts on holder.

## RIGHT BACK

Work as for LEFT BACK, reversing all shaping; work underarm shaping at end of RS rows and BACK shaping at beg of WS row.

## RIGHT FRONT

Work as for LEFT BACK until piece measures 13 (15, 17, 19)" from last cast-on edge, end with a WS row. Bind off all sts.

## LEFT FRONT

Work as for RIGHT BACK until piece measures 13 (**15**, 17, **19**)" from last cast-on edge, end with a WS row.

## Shape Ruffle

**Row 1 (RS)** Knit.

**Rows 2-6** Knit.

**Row 7** K1, \*k1-f/b; rep from \* to last st, k1 – 206 (218, 232, 244) sts.

**Rows 8-10** Work in Garter st.

**Row 11** Rep Row 7 – 410 (434, 462, 486) sts.

**Row 12** Knit. Bind off all sts loosely.

## FINISHING

Block pieces to measurements. With WS's facing each other, join live edges of BACK pieces using 3-Needle Bind-Off. **NOTE:** BACK seam is intended to show on RS. Place marker 4 (**4**, 4¼, **4¼**)" to either side of BACK seam along top edge of BACK. Sew top edges of FRONTS and BACK from cast-on edge to markers. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

## Neckband

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit approximately 3 sts for every 4 rows along top edge of RIGHT FRONT, BACK, and LEFT FRONT.

## Shape Ruffle

**Row 1 (WS)** Knit.

**Rows 2-5 (RS)** Knit.

**Row 6** K1, \*k1-f/b; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 7** Knit.

**Row 8** Rep Row 6. Bind off all sts loosely knitwise.

## Bottom Band

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit approximately 3 sts for every 4 rows along bottom edge of LEFT FRONT, BACK, and RIGHT FRONT. Knit 5 rows. Bind off all sts loosely knitwise.

Weave in ends.

## SPECIAL TERM

**3-NEEDLE BIND OFF:** [Seaming 2 pieces together as you bind off.]

Place sts of pieces to be joined on separate needles, (or each end of a circular needle), hold one behind the other with RS's facing each other, in left hand; with a third needle, (the same size or 1 size larger than used for knitting the pieces), k2tog [1 from front needle, 1 from back needle – 1 st on RH needle], \*k2tog [2 sts on RH needle], bind off 1 st in usual manner; rep from \* to end. For decorative seam on RS, work with wrong sides facing.
