



GAUGE

10 sts and 16 rows = 4"/10 cm in K2, P2 Rib (unstretched)

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

PATTERN STITCHES

K2, P2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts)

ABBREVIATIONS

k knit
 k2tog/p2tog knit/purl 2 sts together
 p purl
 st(s) stitches

 R - #03 stone grey

SIZE One Size

KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

20"/51 cm circumference

MATERIALS

- 1 hank Tahki Yarns Terra Collection **MONTANA**, 100% pure new wool (3.5oz/100g; 130yds/120m) in **color #03 stone grey or #14 sand mix**
- One size 13 (9mm) circular needle, 16"/40cm long
- **OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE**
- One set size 13 (9mm) double-pointed needles (dpn)
- Stitch marker
- Yarn needle

HAT

Using circular needle, cast on 60 sts. Join, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of round.

Work in K2, p2 rib until piece measures 8" from beginning.

Shape Crown

NOTE: Change to double-pointed needles as is necessary.

Round 1 *K2, p2tog; repeat from * around – 45 sts.

Round 2 *K2, p1; repeat from * around.

Round 3 *K2tog, p1; repeat from * around – 30 sts.

Round 4 *K1, p1; repeat from * around.

Round 5 [K2tog] around – 15 sts.

Round 6 [K1, p1] around to last st, k1.

Round 7 [K2tog] around to last 3 sts, k3tog.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and pull to close.

Knot to secure.

Weave in ends.
