



**DONEGAL RIBBED SHRUG with ATTACHED SCARF**  
 designed by Vladimir Tiriokhin



**SIZES** Small/Medium (Large/X-Large)

**KNITTED MEASUREMENTS**

**Scarf length** 68"/173cm  
**Scarf width** 12"/30.5cm  
**Sleeve length** 21 (22)"/53.5 (56)cm

**MATERIALS**

- 6 (8) 3.5oz/100g skeins (183yds/169m) Tahki Yarns DONEGAL TWEED 100% pure new wool in #843 bright blue
- One pair size 9 (5.5mm) needles
- OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE**
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle

**GAUGE**

20 sts and 20 rows = 4"/10 cm in k2, p2 rib

**TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE**

**PATTERN STITCHES**

**K2, p2 rib** (multiple of 4 sts)  
 All Rows: \*K2, p2; rep from \* across.

**K2, p2 rib** (multiple of 4 + 2 extra sts)  
**Row 1:** K2, \* p2, k2; repeat from \* across.  
**Row 2:** P2, \* k2, p2; repeat from \* across.  
 Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for k2, p2 rib.

**SCARF**

Cast on 60 sts.  
**(RS)** Begin k2, p2 rib; work even until piece measures 15" from beginning, end with a wrong-side row. **(RS)** (K2, p2) 5 times, k2, bind off 14 sts, (k2, p2) 6 times.  
**(WS)** (K2, p2) 6 times, cast on 14 sts, p2, (k2, p2) 5 times.  
 Continue in k2, p2 rib until piece measures 68" from beginning.  
 Bind off in rib.

**SHRUG**

Cast on 62 (82) sts.  
**(RS)** Begin k2, p2 rib; work even until piece measures 70 (75)" from beginning, end with a wrong-side row.  
 Bind off in rib.

**FINISHING**

- Block pieces to measurements. Fold shrug in half lengthwise and place markers around center 22 (25)" of shrug. Sew side seams from each end to marker to form sleeves, starting with the seam on the right-side for the first 3" for cuff, then bringing seam to wrong-side until you reach the marker.
- Matching the center of the scarf to the center back of the shrug, sew scarf to shrug all along back opening of shrug and 1" on either side of front opening of shrug.
- Weave in ends. Turn sleeves back 3" to form cuff
